

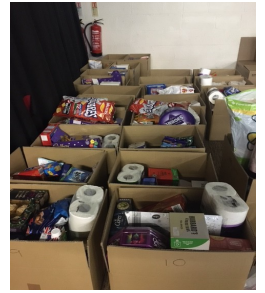

The aftermath of the First World War saw the biggest single wave of public commemoration ever

with tens of thousands of memorials erected across England, both as a result of the huge impact the loss of three quarters of a million British lives had on communities and the official policy of not repatriating the dead, which meant that the memorials provided the main focus of the grief felt at this great loss.

One such memorial was raised at Stoney Stanton. The granite base was given by the local quarry and the rest funded by public subscription, to commemorate the 43 parishioners who lost their lives during the conflict. It was unveiled on 7th January 1921 by Colonel R Martin and a service was conducted by the Revd Disney of the time and the memorial was dedicated by The Archdeacon of Leicester. We remembered its unveiling and dedication 101 years ago on 7th January 2022 at 10.45am.
