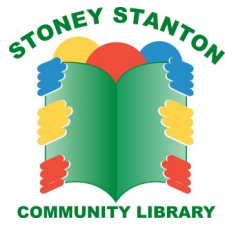

## Leicestershire County Council's public consultation on the Draft Resources and Waste Strategy for Leicestershire (2022-2050) is now underway... have your say.

This strategy is the work of the Leicestershire Waste Partnership, of which Blaby District Council is a part of, with the ultimate aim of working to "achieving a net zero carbon by 2050 in Leicestershire." The draft strategy includes 11 pledges, including reducing waste sent to landfill to just 5% by 2025, achieving a 65% recycling rate by 2035 and the exploration of alternative fuels for collection vehicles.
