Stoney Stanton Parish Council Community Awards 2023

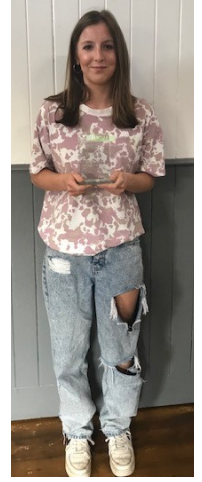
The George Hill Award for Sporting Achievement HARVEY GOODWIN

Cllr Sue Astill presented the award to Harvey for his achievements in Swimming, at the Hinckley Club annual championships he entered 12 events and won 12 medals (4 gold, 6 silver and 3 bronze along with 8 personal best times). At the Leicester Sharks event he won 6 medals (1 gold, 2 silvers and 3 bronzes).



Outstanding Achievement for a young person LUCY STRATFORD

Cllr Rebecca Bateman presented the award to Lucy for her fundraising and her commitment to sport. Lucy raised £2500 for a Childrens Mental Health Charity by doing a 26 mile walking marathon. She qualified for the County Cross Country races, plays Hockey with the Leicester Wolves but her main sport is Tennis, she plays for the SSTC since she was 7 and has won the Road to Wimbledon Tournament twice. At 14 she became the youngest ever winner of 'Ladies Singles Champion'.



The Community Smile Award SUE TAYLOR

Cllr Sarah Eaves presented the award to Sue in recognition of her being a long standing member of the Carnival committee and for her Christmas house decorations and Santa letters she takes time to do. Sue dresses the outside of her home at Christmas for everyone to enjoy along with a Santa post box and every child who writes to Santa via Sue receives an individual reply, therefore bringing some Christmas magic.



The Chris Fulton Award for Outstanding Service to the Community DEBBIE ROACH

Cllr Francis Gent presented the award to Debbie. Debbie received 13 nominations (the most ever received) for her work with running the Creative Childrens Group and Stitchers, child minding for working parents, she is much loved by the children. Her volunteer works as school governor, member of the carnival committee and many other roles over the years. She is a friendly, welcoming much loved familiar face.

Cllr Jade Lundeau presented the award to Alison, Mike and their daughter Hannah. The nominations were received as this couple were behind the 'Poppy Man' at the memorial
