- 2. Toward the end of October, vandals burnt down toilets at Fosse Meadows Nature Area just days after the disabled unit was replaced due to firework damage. If anyone has any information on this attack, please contact the Police on 101.
- 3. On 1st November, work started on two major facility improvements at Enderby Leisure and Golf Centre: addition of a state-of-the-art soft play, and a car park extension. Work is due to be completed by the first week of January 2024, and will include a number of provisions for juniors and babies. Please see the full brief provided to Parish Councils for more information.
- The latest round of the Community Grants Scheme is now open, offering £500

 £4,000 for local charities, community groups and sports clubs. The last round saw a total of £13,054.05 awarded to 13 organisations.
