
QEII COMMUNITY ORCHARD

The Old School Surgery Patient Participation Group - Update

The PPG Group reformed again last year after COVID and with new volunteers. The primary purpose of the Patients Participation Group is to represent the views and experiences of ALL member patients at the surgery. This is to help the surgery be proactive in providing services that reflect the requirements of the patients. Our mission is to aid communications between the GP Surgery and Patients.

To date the PPG have conducted a patient's survey and assisted with the COVID vaccination weekends (car parking and surveys). Attended Integrated Care Board information days, looked at patients' areas of concerns and how we might assist in communicating changes. We are in the process of suggesting improvements to the website and looking at producing quarterly information articles.

The NHS and GP Surgeries have experienced significant change since COVID and The Old School Surgery is no different. They are supporting approx. 8,000 patients primarily in the villages of Elmesthorpe, Sapcote, Sharnford, Stoney Stanton and Thurlaston.

During a typical month they can deal with in excess of 6,000 telephone calls. More face to face appointments are being requested by patients and were added in January 2024. The PPG encourage all patients to embrace the changes where possible, by using online services to book appointments and order prescriptions. These are available on the Surgery website www.theoldschoolsurgery.com . You will need to visit the surgery in person to get a login and password to begin. The NHS APP is also available to patients and will give you access to such thing as medical records and test results. This can be downloaded to your phone. We are planning a joint training session on this subject with the surgery which will be open to patients. Look out for further details if you are interested on the surgery website, face book page or by contacting the surgery.

There is also a Practice Information Leaflet available at the surgery containing a range of information about the surgery and it services.

Beginning shortly the surgery will be undergoing a re-fit, initially in the reception area, so some understanding and tolerance will be appreciated during this time. For more information about the PPG please contact the surgery theoldschool.surgery1@nhs.net
