COUNCIL TAX - How will it affect you?

We know that residents have had a very hard year both emotionally and financially and we would like to confirm that there will be a *small* increase in the amount of the precept we request from the District Council for the next financial year.

Due to the changes in the tax base rate and an increase of 3.9% we will be asking for an additional annual charge of £3.30 (27.5p a month) meaning the charge for a Band D household will go from £84.53 to £87.83.

The parish receives less than 5% of each household council tax bill.

Stoney Stanton Youth Club meets every **Thursday from 6-8pm** at Stoney Stanton Village Hall. The group welcomes children from the age of 8 to 16 years old.

Funded by Stoney Stanton Parish Council, in association with Youth Leicestershire, the group offers 2 hours of independent activities, friendship, socialising with peers and of course the much loved tuck shop.

It's **£1 per child** and runs weekly during the school year; quite often holding additional events during the school holidays. Follow their updates on **Facebook** at **Stoney Stanton Youth Club**. Pre-booking is not required, however parent's do need to complete a registration form on the child's first time attendance.

The Community Library are pleased to be

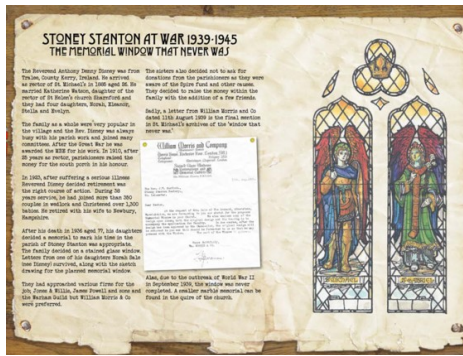
working in collaboration with the Stoney Stanton Heritage Group to host their presentation 'Stoney Stanton at War 1939-1945'.
