### COMMUNITY GRANT UPDATE

Blaby District Council are still offering grants between £500 - £4000 to cover different project costs to a range of voluntary and community sector organisations. There will be four application rounds this year with the first deadline for applications on Wednesday 31 May at 5pm. We have also made some changes to the scheme for this year. This includes increasing the total project cost limit to £40k, prioritising applications that relate to rising energy costs or those that support residents struggling with the cost of living challenges, and changing the eligibility criteria for some organisations.
