## FLY TIPPED OIL IN THE SWALE


A large amount of oil had been fly-tipped into one the culverts that flows into the swale on the Persimmon Estate. This inconsiderate act



has damaged the swale and caused issue into the water course. We worked with the Environmental Agency and a local company to remove the oil and make the area as safe as possible. This act has also cost the parish council over £1200 which in theory the residents have paid for through the council tax.

## PASQUILL TIMBER DONATIONS
